Non-Public School Safety Equipment

Purpose: The NPSF grant provides religious and independent schools with expenditures related to certain safety and health expenses.

Eligibility: Eligibility has been pre-determined based on NYSED data, by Chapter 34, section 1, of the law of 2022. The criteria for eligibility includes:

1. Currently open schools.
2. Religious and independent schools (non-profit or not-for-profit schools only).
3. 853 and 4201 schools (meeting all other criteria).
4. Possession of (or will obtain) a valid State Office of the State Comptroller (OSC) Vendor ID.
5. The New York State Education System (BEDS) code.
6. BEDS enrollment data for the 2022-2023 school year (or high school students only).

Expenses: Starting in year 10, ORISS developed qualifying/nonqualifying expense lists. To access those lists, please visit the NPSF web site. If a school needs assistance in determining an expense, please email oriss@nysed.gov.

Pooling: Pooling of funds is when related agencies have collaborative items/services and wish to combine their allocations into one claim at application. Pooling is optional and not commonly utilized. The NPSF 10 Continuation and the NPSF 10 Education Notice Action documents include pool eligibility and directions.
